### **Pacific County Sheriff's Office Detectives Arrest Suspect on Multiple Incest Charges Following FBI Investigation**

**SEAVIEW, WA** - On May 28, 2026, detectives with the Pacific County Sheriff's Office arrested a 27-year-old male on multiple counts of incest. The arrest and subsequent investigation were triggered while local authorities were assisting the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) with a search warrant at a residence in Seaview. The suspect is currently facing one count of Incest in the First Degree and one count of Incest in the Second Degree.

The case came to light while Pacific County personnel were on scene assisting federal agents with a search warrant focused on the suspect for separate charges associated with online communications with a minor and child pornography. During the execution of the federal warrant, a female occupant of the home was questioned and disclosed a history of physical and sexual abuse perpetrated by her older brother. This immediate disclosure prompted Pacific County Sheriff's Office detectives to open a separate case to investigate the allegations.

Pacific County detectives interviewed the female victim at the residence. She detailed multiple incidents that occurred between 2016 and 2017 while they were living together in a home in Long Beach. According to the victim, who was approximately 14 years old at the time. The victim described instances of forced inappropriate touching, oral sexual assault, and attempted sexual assault.

Following the victim's interview and additional background interviews with family members, Pacific County deputies contacted the 27-year-old suspect at the Sheriff's Office, where he was being detained. The suspect participated in a recorded interview with detectives. During the questioning, the suspect admitted to inappropriately touching the victim and confessed to multiple instances of sexual assault matching her account. Furthermore, the suspect disclosed four additional instances of abuse that had not been previously reported.

The suspect was taken into custody and booked into the Pacific County Jail. Due to the suspect's additional admissions, detectives are continuing their follow-up investigation to determine if further criminal charges will be filed.

Legal Reminder: PCSO reminds the community that all suspects are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law. An arrest does not constitute a conviction, but rather signifies that probable cause has been established.
